(Power and Control Wheel, Duluth Project)
- Biblically: Power over vs. Power under Matthew 22:25-26, Mark 10:45
 - o 4 Pillars of Abuse

- Point to Jesus
 - o Who does Jesus say she is? Ephesians 1, 2, 3, 4, 5:1-2

 - Thinking/Actions? Ephesians 5:3-5
 - Responses? Ephesians 5:6-14
 - Worship? Ephesians 5:15-21
 - Relationships? Ephesians 5:22-6:9
